Direct Object Pronouns:

A direct object is the noun or pronoun that receives the action of a transitive verb in the ACTIVE voice and is formed in the objective case. It is the objective complement that answers the question, "What?" or "Whom?" An objective pronoun is a word used instead of a noun to name an object. Say it! Write it! Repeat it!

The toy bumped you.

The sun warmed him.

The drink cooled her.

The coals cooked it.

The sound reached us.

The schedule skipped you all.
