## Verbs - Future Perfect Tense:

The future perfect tense of a verb expresses action or state that is completed at or before a certain future time and is formed by adding "shall have" or "will have" before the past tense of the base verb. Say it! Write it! Repeat it!

*I shall have left by that time.*

*You will have kept six by that time.*

*He will have arrived by*

*Christmas.*

*She will have eaten by this afternoon.*

*It will have returned before next week.*
