A gerund is a verb that is used as a noun and is formed by adding –ing. The joy of cooking is yours. “Cooking” is the object of the preposition “of” and is used as a noun.

A gerund can be used as a subject, direct object, indirect object, object of a preposition, predicate nominative, and as an appositive because it can be used as a noun.

A gerund phrase is a group of words that consists of a gerund and of the words that modify or complement it.
